1st step: Visit of Nabeul the capital of pottery and also famous for water distillation of orange blossom, visit a workshop making pottery then free time in the souks.

2nd stage, visit the fort of Hammamet and its maze of tangled streets. The fort (Kasbah) is located at the western corner of the Medina, overlooking the sea. Old nearly 7 centuries, it is still beautifully preserved. The fort was built under the orders of Bel Hadj Hamouda Fraj in 1474 to strengthen the city's defenses against foreign invasions. A mint tea and Tunisian pastries are served at Café Sidi Bouhadid
